INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES

Candidates for the University Examinations are required to observe the following Instructions carefully:

Applications for admission to this examination must be forwarded so as to reach the Director, School of Distance Education not later than the notified date and must be accompanied by the receipt for the fee paid.

The fee prescribed for the examination including fee for marks, stationery and Provisional Certificate as follows:

Whole Examination	: ₹.600/-
For One Subject	: ₹.300/-
For Two Subjects and Above	: ₹.600/-

1. Improvement: Provision for LL.M. Course is allowed within a period of three years from the year of passing the examination. Hence, the candidates, who passed LL.M. in 2008 or later are eligible to take whole examination either Previous or Final under this provision.

2. Paper-wise Improvement is also allowed only for one chance, i.e., immediately after passing the examination. Hence, the candidates, who passed in 2010 examination are only eligible to avail Paper - wise betterment provision.

3. An amount of ₹.1,000/- is to be paid towards improvement fee pay year besides the usual examination fee.

The Fee Once paid will in no circumstances be returned or held over for a subsequent examination.

i) Candidates should read instructions before filling up application.

ii) Candidates should enclose a self-addressed covers 2 Nos. (9"x4 ")

iii) Enclose Identity Card Xerox copy.

iv) The candidates who appeared previously have to enclose Xerox copies of Marks statements compulsorily otherwise their application will not be processed.

v) Candidates submitting Dissertations or appearing for Viva-Voce Exam exclusively have also to submit Examination application for Registration along with the prescribed fee i.e., ₹.300/- per subject paper not exceeding ₹.600/- for each year.

Instructions to Candidates appearing for Examinations

Candidates for University Examination are required to observe the following instructions very carefully.

1. Applicants are advised to collect their Hall-Tickets from the SDE, three days before the commencement of examinations.
2. Silence should be maintained in the examination hall.
3. Candidates should take their places in the examination Hall at least five minutes before the time fixed for distributing the papers. Candidates presenting themselves more than half an hour after the appointed time will not be admitted to the examination Hall. Candidates who are undoubtedly suffering from infectious diseases of any kind will not be admitted.
4. Candidates should bring their hall tickets with them to the examination Hall each day of the examination for inspection by the Chief Superintendent.
5. Candidates are prohibited from writing upon their Hall-tickets or question papers. Candidates are also prohibited from writing their names or any other name connected with the answers on any part of the answer books. The Register Number should be written very distinctly on the title page of the main answer book. Failure to write their Register Number may involve the rejection of answer papers. They should fill in the subject year on the outer cover of the main answer book.
6. No candidates will be allowed to leave the examination Hall till the expiry of at least an hour and a half after the question paper was given out, and no candidate who leaves the hall during the period allotted for a paper will be allowed to return within the period.
7. Candidates are forbidden to ask questions of any kind during the examination. They are further forbidden to communicate with the examiners, should they do so, their answer papers will not be valued and their conduct will be reported to the executive council for disciplinary action.
8. Candidates are not allowed the use of books of any kind (except as provided as rule No.9) They are also prohibited from introducing into the Examination Hall any book, slate, blotting pad, card board, manuscript, type script or paper of any description and from making use of any of these whether introduced into the hall by themselves or by any one else, from communicating with or copying from each other and from communicating with any person outside the Examination Hall. Any candidate detected on the violation of these rules will be summarily sent out of the Hall forthwith and his conduct will be reported to the Director. Such candidates stand the risk of having all his answer papers for the Examination for which he has appeared rejected the E.C and of being debarred from sitting for the university Examination for such period as the E.C may decide.
9. Clark's mathematical and physical Tables will be supplied to candidates in Mathematics. Candidates should not bring in to the Examination Hall their own copies. Scientific calculators (non-programmable) are allowed.
10. Candidates are required to provide themselves with their own pens. Candidates may bring into the examination Hall their own inkbottles. They must however use only black ink while answering the question papers.
11. Particular attention is requested to the instructions regarding rough working and loose sheet paper, printed on the answer books. Answers should not be written on the reverse on the title page of the main answer book. Answers should be written on both sides of the remaining pages of the answer book. All rough work must be done on the right hand side of the problem itself leaving the margin for that purpose with the heading 'rough work' underlined. The number of each question as given in the question paper should be noted both on the margin and in the center of the page of the answer book just above the respective answer. No separate books for rough Working will be supplied to candidates. Papers should not be detached from the answer books. If the ordinary answer books are found insufficient, additional books will be supplied and these should be securely fastened to the main answer books by thread, which can be had from the superintendent.
12. When candidates have finished writing their answers and wish to give up their answers Books, or at the end of the period prescribed for each particular part of examination, each should stand up in his place and remain standing until one of the superintendents has gone up to him and has received his answer books from him.
13. Candidates sitting for the examination at the different centers should apply the Superintendent of the respective center for their hall Tickets three days before the commencement of the respective Examinations. Any particulars noted in the hall-tickets differing from those given in the applicant for the examination, should be immediately reported to the Chief Superintendent by the concerned candidate.
14. Candidates appearing at the centers where they are not known must be prepared to satisfy the chief Superintendents of such centers as to their identity. They shall also be required to sign on the identification certificates produced by them before the Chief Superintendents of the respective centers, 'the identification Certificates may be obtained either from the principal of an Affiliated College of the University or from in Government not lower in rank than a Sub-Magistrate in Andhra Pradesh.

Submission of the Examination Application Form:

The candidate has to send the duly filled-in Application form on or before the last date as specified above. However, applications will be accepted with a penal fee of ₹.300/- from 07.07.2011 to 13.07.2011 and ₹.500/- from 14.07.2011 to 20.07.2011. Applications received after the due date i.e., 20.07.2011, incomplete and defective applications will be summarily rejected. The candidate has to carefully go through the instructions given in the Application form before filling the application. The candidate should note that the application form contains the Hall-Tickets in duplicate also. The signature of the candidate is necessary both on the Hall-Ticket and Examination Application form.

Note:

All the students who are on the rolls of the School of Distance Education, who attended PCP classes with a minimum of 75% attendance are only eligible to take this examination. They are also further directed to clear the tuition fee dues before they take Hall-Tickets for the examination. Final year students have to submit 2 copies of dissertation before commencement of the examination i.e.08.08.2011.

Hall-Ticket:

The candidate has to collect the Hall-Ticket from the Chief Superintendent of the respective Examination Centre within three days before the commencement of the examination. No further intimation will be sent to the candidate in this regard.
