Programmes in Software Engg./CSIT/Civil Engg./Mechanical Engg./Electrical & Electronics Engg./Applied Chemistry/ Geology and Economics**, you are requested to appear for counselling as per the schedule given overleaf, at the **Dr.B.R.Ambedkar Auditorium, A.U. College of Engineering (A), Visakhapatnam** at your own expenses with all original certificates specified below. Since the candidates called for counselling are more than the number of seats available, mere receipt of this intimation is not a guarantee of admission. All admissions are subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria specified in the brochure.

Original certificates to be produced at the time of counseling:

1. Rank card and Hall-ticket of the 5 Year Integrated M.S. Program entrance examination - 2009.
2. Pass certificate of Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent qualifying examination.
3. Statement of Marks of qualifying examination
4. Transfer and Conduct certificate from the institution where he/she last studied.
5. Date of birth certificate (S.S.C. / equivalent certificate)
6. Migration certificate wherever necessary
7. Study certificates of last 7 years from the qualifying examination
8. Physical fitness certificate
9. One set of attested copies of all the above certificates.
10. Nativity/ Residence of the parent for the last 10 years or study certificates of the candidate from 1st standard onwards for other states category.
11. Integrated community certificate issued by competent authority, in case of SC/ST/BC candidates.
12. Recent Income certificate issued after 01-01-2009 by competent authority, in case of eligible SC/ST/BC/ EBC candidates claiming fee concession.
13. Certificate in respect of claim under special category (CAP/NCC/PH/Sports) wherever applicable in prescribed form.
14. D.D. drawn in favour of **Admission Account, Directorate of Admissions, Andhra University** payable at Visakhapatnam for the prescribed fee as per the fee structure given on the back side of this memo.

NOTE:

1. Admission will be made according to the rank obtained in the concerned test in AUCET-2009 and based on the rules noted in the Admission Information Brochure-2009 and the distribution of seats for different categories in various 5 Year Integrated Courses offered by A.U. See University Website www.andhrauniversity.info/doa for full details.
2. Candidate seeking admission into a particular course should fulfill all eligibility criteria for that course as specified in the admission information brochure of AUCET-2009. Such of those candidates who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria and do not have all of the relevant certificates will not be permitted for counseling. Candidates passed in Instant Examination of 2009 are also eligible for admission. Candidates passed in advanced supplementary / supplementary examinations of 2009 are not eligible for admission.
3. Candidates have to submit Demand Draft(s) drawn in favour of “**Admission account, Directorate of Admissions**” payable at Visakhapatnam from any nationalised bank for the prescribed course fee as given in the enclosure along with the certificates.
4. All certificates related to reservation categories like SC, ST, LBC etc. are subject to scrutiny by appropriate Government agencies.
5. Candidates seeking admission under Sports, PH, NCC, CAP are directed to appear before admission committee along with all original certificates in support of the claim for verification by the Committee. The admissions are based on the priorities fixed by the panel of experts and subject to availability of seats in the particular course / college, according to the rules mentioned in Admission Information Brochure AUCET-2009. Only local candidates are eligible for admission under NCC, PH, CAP and Sports categories.
6. **NO EXTENSION OF TIME EITHER FOR PRODUCING CERTIFICATES OR FOR PAYMENT OF FEE SHALL BE GRANTED AND NO CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ENTERTAINED IN THIS REGARD.**
7. Cancellation of admission will be made with a refund of 90% of the total fee paid.

General Instructions:

1. The number of candidates called for interview is generally 5 to 10 times the number of seats available. The admission process is likely to continue for the next day. The candidates should come prepared to stay for one or two days more.
2. Admission of a candidate is purely provisional. The University reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage. Candidates getting admission by producing false information / certificates are liable for prosecution. Their seats will be cancelled without any notice on the detection of fraud at any time during their course of study.
3. Admission is liable to be cancelled, if the student does not put in continuous attendance for a period of 10 days without valid reason from the date of commencement of the classes.
4. SC/ST/BC/EBC candidates seeking admission into P.G. courses and whose parental / guardian annual income is less than Rs.1,00,000/- are eligible for the sanction of course fee by the Department of Social / Tribal Welfare, Andhra Pradesh.
5. Sanction of course fee under post-metric scholarship to eligible SC / ST / BC / EBC students studying regular / self-finance courses at postgraduate level is limited to Rs.20,000/- per year only (as per G.O.Ms. No. 56, W.W. Edn.2 Dept., Dated 6-10-2003). The extra fee amount over and above Rs.20,000/- has to be paid by the candidates at the time of counseling for admission.
6. However, if the candidate does not get the sanction of the course fee amount by the Department of Social Welfare, Andhra Pradesh, he/she has to pay the prescribed course fee mentioned in the enclosure. The candidate has to give an undertaking at the time of admission to this effect.
7. Changes in admission schedule, if any, will be intimated by post and also by newspapers / All India Radio and Doordarshan announcements and through website. Do not rely on telegrams; they may be false.
8. Education Tours / Training Programmes / Field Works wherever prescribed are compulsory. Such of those courses will not be deemed to be completed unless required programmes are attended by the students.
9. Limited Hostel accommodation is available for the students who get admission in the University Campus. Hence, University cannot ensure hostel accommodation to all students. Candidates seeking admission into hostels are advised to bring five copies of passport size photos and photocopies of caste and income certificate each in duplicate. Hostel admission will be made by the Chief Warden of the respective Hostel subject to availability of accommodation as per the University Hostel rules in force from time to time.
