**Notes:**

1. Admission into M.E./M.Tech.(for locally employed people) / M.Pharmacy courses shall be processed as per the following order of preference (i) Valid Gate qualified rank card, (ii) rank in PGECET-2008 and (iii) percentage of marks obtained in the qualifying examination.
2. Candidates who do not fulfill the eligibility criteria / do not have all of the relevant certificates will not be permitted for counseling.
3. Candidates have to submit Demand Draft on any Nationalised bank drawn in favour of “**Admission Account, Directorate of Admissions, A.U.**” payable at Visakhapatnam for the prescribed amount. Admission will not be processed without D.D. for the admission fee as specified.
4. All certificates in respect of reservation categories like SC, ST, LBC, Caste conversion, etc., are subject to scrutiny by appropriate Governmental agencies.
5. **No extension of time either for producing certificates or for payment of fee shall be granted and no correspondence will not be entertained in this regard.**
6. Admission of a candidate is purely provisional. University reserves the right to cancel the admission at any stage. Candidates getting admission by producing false information / certificates are liable for prosecution. Seats of such candidates will be cancelled without any notice on the detection of fraud at any time during their course of study.
7. The number of candidates called for interview is generally 5 to 10 times the number of seats available. The admission process is likely to continue for the next day. The candidates should come prepared to stay for one or two days more.
8. If the number of students admitted in any course in less than 5, such course will not be conducted.
9. Admissions for candidates under SPORTS/PH/NCC/CAP are based on the priorities fixed by the panel of experts and subject to availability of seats. Only local candidates are eligible for admission under NCC, PH, CAP and Sports categories.
