**TO WHOMSOEVER IT MAY CONCERN**

Andhra University School of Distance Education, Visakhapatnam is offering B.A. / B.Com courses (with three year duration period) from the eligible candidates interested to join with us.

Getting eligibility in the Entrance Examination conducted by the School of Distance Education is one of the requisite eligibility criteria for the admission into the B.A./B.Com. courses besides 10+2 standard of any candidate. Andhra University provides this provision to the candidates, as per the norms prescribed by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi, who completes 18 years of age by the date of this particular examination, who do not qualify the qualifying examination of the recognized Examination Body prescribed therefor. Such candidates have to study their Degree courses through the School of Distance Education, AU. Presently, the 2-year study period I.T.I. holders were also given this provision.

**NOTE :** The University Grants Commission, New Delhi has issued a Circular letter with No. F.1 – 8/92 (CPP-II) dated 04-11-1995 to the Registrars of all the Universities, wherein it was communicated that “No student shall be eligible for admission to the 1<sup>st</sup> degree course through non formal distance education unless he / she has successfully completed 12 years schooling through an examination conducted by a Board/University. In case there is no previous academic record, he/she shall be eligible for admission if he/she shall be eligible for admission if he/she has passed an entrance test conducted by the University, provided that he/she is not below the age of 18 years on 1<sup>st</sup> July of the year of admission).
