## Conference

The 68<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference of the Indian Society of Agricultural Economics is being held at the Andhra University, Visakhapatnam during 28-30 November 2008. Dr. N.S. Jodha Senior Associate Scientist, International Centre for Integrated Mountain Development, (ICIMOD), Kathmandu, Nepal will preside over the Conference. The Conference aims to bring together a wide spectrum of agricultural economists, policy makers, researchers, bankers and other experts for interactive deliberations and discussions on the following three themes:-

- Triggering Agricultural Development Through Horticulture Crops
- Environmental Degradation and its Correctives in Agricultural sector
- Rain-fed Agriculture

Members of the Society and other paper contributors have already been requested to submit their papers to the Society's office. Paper contributors, whether members of the Society or otherwise, are invited to attend the Conference for active discussions on their contributed papers.

## Venue

Andhra University is not just one of the oldest educational institutions in the Country, but is also the first to be conceived as a residential and teaching-cum-affiliating University, mainly devoted to post-graduate teaching and research. The University is spread in a sprawling campus of Ac. 422 dotted with 121 buildings of Academic, Administrative and support services with a plinth area of about 20 lakhs sq.ft., and 324 staff quarters. The University has recently organized the 95<sup>th</sup> Session of the Indian Science Congress, from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2008. The Prime Minister of India, Dr. Manmohan Singh has inaugurated the Congress and in his address he referred to the University as a **Magnificent University** and has all appreciation for the way the mega event was organised.

School of Economics, one of the oldest and important schools in the University, has highly qualified and well trained faculty, a specialised library, a well-furnished computer lab with internet facility, published 123 books, more than 600 Research Articles and more than 300 Ph.Ds and M.Phils were awarded so far, highlights the academic stature of the school. The School has the proud privilege of hosting annual conference of all the academic and professional bodies.

Agro-Economic Research Centre was established in 1968 by the Ministry of Agriculture, Government of India to carry out problem-oriented research studies in agricultural economics, which have immediate policy implications to Government of India and the States of Andhra Pradesh and Orissa. So far the has completed 125 studies on varied topics of Agriculture Economics and Rural Development.

## Accommodation

Accommodation for the delegates will be arranged at the Andhra University Guest Houses and Hotels. Arrangements will be made only after getting the duly filled-in registration forms, together with registration fee.
